About the Apostolic Christian Church Mission Board of Canada (ACCMBC)

In 2003, a few brothers looked into the current problems faced by our Canadian churches in donating to mission projects. This was necessary due to Canadian laws regarding support of out of country projects. In accordance with these laws, a Canadian charity must exert direction, accountability and control of all its resources and cannot just send money to other organizations without formal agreements. This was done most easily by setting up our own financial entity called the Apostolic Christian Church Mission Board of Canada (ACCMBC). The Mission Board is currently made up of five Trustees and two Elders that serve in an advisory capacity.

We Believe...

... that the command of Jesus Christ is to preach the gospel and to make disciples of all nations (Matt. 28:18-20). This is the primary task of the church. It is the mission of the church, therefore, to demonstrate to the world the will of God and to witness to all people the saving power of God in Christ. Every member has the responsibility to be a witness of Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and to call men to be reconciled to God. The church seeks to lead all people to the obedience of faith. (*We Believe, Sect. 7.1.3*)

Statement of Purpose

The primary goal of the Apostolic Christian Church Mission Board of Canada (ACCMBC) is to provide humanitarian aid and volunteer labour to alleviate human misery and suffering throughout the world in a way that is a Christian witness and brings glory to God. We seek to serve our Lord by sharing our resources and abilities to benefit both the soul and body of those in need, and thereby communicate the love of God through His Son, Jesus Christ.

ACCMBC Objectives

1. Screen and select projects that meet the requirements for charitable giving as determined by both the ACCMBC and the Canadian Government, and to provide the planning, organizing, managing, staffing, and funding of approved projects where needed.
2. Provide opportunities to serve the Lord on a voluntary basis, providing a channel through which volunteers can perform services or help financially to alleviate human suffering.
3. Seek to help others by teaching and helping them to help themselves.
4. Address the needs that result when natural or man-made disasters occur
5. To provide scholarships and bursaries for eligible students attending Christian Schools
6. Serve as ambassadors for Jesus Christ and representatives of the Apostolic Christian Church (Nazarean), reflecting our love for God and the church by our actions and appearance, thus communicating the gospel message supported by sound doctrine.
7. To share the gospel of Jesus Christ and to encourage people to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour by communicating the gospel through various means.

How can I get involved?

Contact your local church treasurer, or an ACCMBC trustee, or go to the ACCMBC website (www.accmbc.org) to find out about current projects.

Child Sponsorship Program

An opportunity to be directly involved in the lives of children that are abused, neglected, orphaned, disabled or just born in economically distressed areas of the world (see corresponding pamphlet).

Work Teams

Work teams are organized every year for projects in Brazil, Paraguay, Mexico, the United States, Canada and throughout the world as the need arises and resources are available (see corresponding pamphlet).

Essential Needs

There are many opportunities to get involved at a local level in your church to make health kits, bandages, school kits, clothing drives or a local food bank. There's work for everyone! If these events aren't available, contact your local ACCMBC Trustee or church leadership and begin one.

Benevolence Fund

This fund is used to financially assist or alleviate suffering for individuals, families or communities on an emergency or disaster relief basis.

Eastern Europe Relief

Many brethren in Eastern Europe are struggling financially due to natural disasters, job loss and heavy financial burdens and are in need of assistance.

Bible Fund

There is a Bible Fund that is used to print and distribute Bibles in the native language of the culture requesting them.

Church Representatives

Each local congregation has its own church treasurer who is a vital link in our chain of service. Along with the ACCMBC trustees, the local church treasurer can provide answers to questions about the opportunities mentioned above.

Prayer and Financial Support

Many people may find it difficult to physically participate in any of these projects due to a variety of circumstances. You can still play an integral part in missions by being a "Macedonian Missionary" – *"Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia; how that ... the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality. ... they were willing of themselves; praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints"* (2 Cor. 8:1-4).

You have an opportunity to be a blessing to those in need by praying and being a good steward of the financial resources that God has provided and entrusted into your hand.
